The new Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw 5/2016 came into effect January 1, 2017. The new bylaw includes animal registration for both **dogs & cats**. Licencing/registration has become lifetime — with an annual renewal requirement. Pet owners can now pick up their registration tags for dogs and cats at Civic Hall. As we enter 2017 and the Municipal Election process begins, Morinville will be holding candidate information sessions for those who are thinking of running for office. The sessions will highlight the nomination requirements, election legislation, campaign requirements, what to expect as a Councillor, and Council compensation.

The first candidate information session will be held on **Monday, February 27 beginning at 6:30 p.m.** in Council Chambers (2nd floor, 10125-100 Avenue). The session will follow the Candidates Handbook which will be made available at the information session or on our website at www.morinville.ca/election the next day.

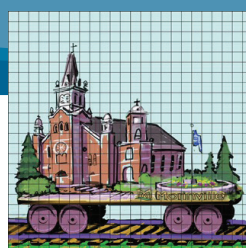
