Town Reminders

Crack Sealing

The annual crack sealing program involves the cleaning and sealing of road cracks in order to extend the useful life of the roadway by not allowing surface water to seep into the base of the road. Please exercise caution when driving in the area while personnel are working.

Property Tax Deadline

Morinville Property Taxes are due on or before June 30. All current taxes unpaid as of June 30, 2017 are subject to a **penalty of 7.5%**. Any unpaid taxes outstanding at December 31, 2017 are subject to a **penalty of 9%**. Should you have any questions, please call 780.939.4361.

Sidewalk/Trail Repair Program

Annually, from June to September, Public Works staff undertakes the restoration of old trails, sidewalks, and shale paths, as well as adding new trail segments to connect certain areas of Morinville's existing walkways.
