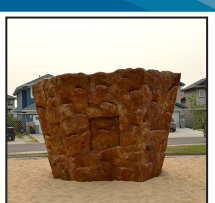
If you are a not-for-profit organization, community group, team, or association of Morinville and have projects that benefit our community, you may qualify for assistance through the Community Grant Program.

Heritage Lake - Blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) advisory

Alberta Health Services issued a blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) bloom advisory for Heritage Lake on July 27, 2018.

The advisory remains in effect until further notice.

Residents living near the shores of Heritage Lake and visitors to the lake are advised to avoid all contact with blue-green algae (cyanobacteria). If contact occurs, wash with tap water as soon as possible. Do not swim or wade in any areas where blue-green algae (cyanobacteria) is visible. Do not allow your pets in the water.

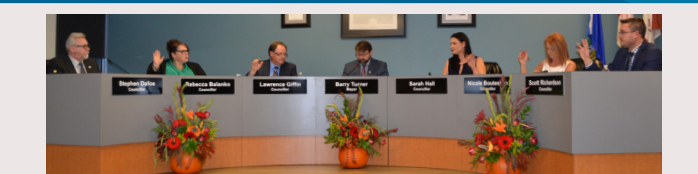
