Assessment Review Boards (ARB) are made up of a Local Assessment Review Board (LARB) and a Composite Assessment Review Board (CARB). These Boards are established under the *Municipal Government Act (MGA)* to hear and decide matters relating to property assessments or other matters on an assessment or tax notice.
