

RESPONSIBLE PET OWNERSHIP Bylaw 5/2016 2018 ANIMAL REGISTRATION/ANNUAL RENEWAL REQUIREMENT

Please be aware that in accordance with Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw 5/2016 any animal (dogs or cats) that reside within Morinville Town limits are subject to registration.

For any animal(s) that were registered in 2017 there will be a \$10 renewal fee per animal. A new tag will not be issued. If you require a replacement tag there will be an additional charge of \$10.

Payment for your animal registration renewal must be made in person by cash, cheque, debit or credit card at the Morinville Town Office (10125-100 Avenue).

Any new animals or previously unregistered animal will be subject to the fee schedule of Bylaw 5/2016. Please stop by the Town Office to complete necessary paperwork. If you no longer have a previously registered animal please notify us at 780.939.4361 so we can update our records.

PUBLIC HEARING Land Use Bylaw Amendment

(MGA Decision Making Timelines)

You are invited to attend a Public Hearing for a Land Use Bylaw Amendment and provide your comments directly to Council. If you prefer to write to Council, send your written comments to the Legislative Officer before 4:30 pm on December 11th, 2017. These comments will be reviewed as part of the hearing process.

What is the Land Use Bylaw Amendment about?

The purpose of Bylaw 14/2017 is to amend the Land Use Bylaw (LUB) to make it consistent with recent amendments to the Municipal Government Act (MGA) with respect to decision making timelines, specifically to:

- incorporate new procedures for determining completeness of subdivision and development permit applications and integrate them within the existing development permit process framework of the LUB,
- clarify contents and timeframes for development permit decisions and notices, and
- adjust timelines for filing a notice of appeal on a development permit application.

How Will This Affect Me?

The proposed amendments to the LUB conform to the revised provisions of the MGA and are necessary to ensure the LUB continues to be valid.
