Waste Collection — Cart Reminder

Please be reminded that weekly garbage collection for household waste is calculated on all waste being contained within the waste cart with the lid closed. The Town will not be responsible if GFL refuses to collect containers that have excess waste in them. As of March 1, 2018 GFL will be much stricter with residents and will no longer accept over-filled containers. Residents are able to rent additional waste containers if they feel they need them on a regular basis. Alternatively, should a resident require disposal of refuse over and above the usual weekly pickup they may utilize a user pay disposal permit system at Roseridge landfill. The landfill permit allows residents with a utility account to dispose of any extra waste (garbage, or organics). Landfill permits can be picked up at Morinville Civic Hall, 10125-100 Avenue Monday to Friday from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm (except Holidays).

Firefighting is a very rewarding, challenging, exciting and fulfilling career.

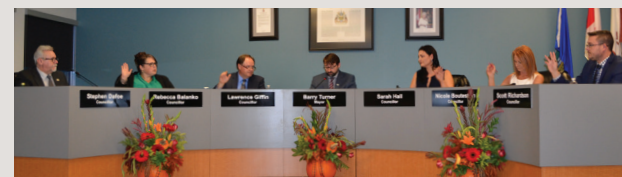
