### Town Reminders

#### Budget 2018

On Tuesday, February 27, 2018 Council passed 3rd Reading of the 2018 Operating Budget and 2018-2037 Long Range Capital Plan. Amendments by Council through 2nd and 3rd Reading culminated in the proposed 6% tax increase decreasing to an approximate 0.7% tax increase. Thank you to all for your engagement and input into Budget 2018. Your continued feedback and input greatly assists Council in the tough decisions they have to make.

#### Waste Collection — Cart Reminder

Please be reminded that weekly garbage collection for household waste is calculated on all waste being contained within the waste cart with the lid closed. The Town will not be responsible if GFL refuses to collect containers that have excess waste in them. As of March 1, 2018 GFL will be much stricter with residents and will no longer accept over-filled containers. Residents are able to rent additional waste containers if they feel they need them on a regular basis. Alternatively, should a resident require disposal of refuse over and above the usual weekly pickup, they may utilize a user pay disposal permit system at Roseridge landfill. The landfill permit allows residents with a utility account to dispose of extra waste (garbage, or organics) at a rate of .0368 cents per kg. Landfill permits can be picked up at Morinville Civic Hall, 10125-100 Avenue Monday to Friday from 8:00 am to 4:30 pm (except Holidays).

### Sidewalk Snow Clearing

Under the Town's **Traffic Safety Bylaw 24/2012**, persons owning, controlling, or occupying property are required to remove snow, ice, dirt, or other materials to bare pavement **within 72 hours** of the time when the snow, ice, dirt, or other material was formed or deposited thereon. Enforcement Services is conducting proactive patrols for of all areas; however, encourages residents to register any complaints to ensure additional concerns are looked into by calling 780.939.7831 or by emailing concerns to [peaceofficer@morinville.ca](mailto:peaceofficer@morinville.ca).
